OUR TOGETHERNESS

We do not tolerate any unacceptable behavior on our premises.

- We will not allow any forms of discrimination, including but not limited to sexism, racism, ableism, or anti-queerness.
- No physical or psychological violence, hate speech, threats, or aggressive communication is permitted
- no symbols associated with right-wing or extreme nationalist groups are allowed

Every participant, visitor, and contributor is responsible for maintaining a respectful atmosphere. Mindfulness, consideration, and solidarity are our key guidelines.

BOUNDARIES AND CONSENSUS

Everyone has their boundaries, and these must be respected. Respect your boundaries and say no if something is not okay. Also, respect the boundaries of others. Please refrain from arguing about their feelings. Only a clear 'yes' is a 'yes'. Consensus is not a permanent authorization. If you are unsure, ask.

AWARENESS AND SAFER SPACES

An awareness team will be present throughout the event, identifiable by their pink caps and vests featuring a capital "A" on the back. It offers support in stressful situations, listens to the situation, and stands by the affected person. At the Awareness Point, you will discover a sheltered retreat with a low-stimulus environment.

THOUGHTFUL SELECTION OF COSTUME

Please avoid costumes that stereotype or disrespect cultures. Cultural appropriation hurts, even if it is unintentional. We would like to see creative outfits that do not exclude or stereotype anyone.
